PLEASE NOTE:

- For existing courses and course development, faculty stipends are available in the range of \$2,500-\$10K per faculty member per semester, depending on the number of sessions and replicability.
- For non-course, non-classroom projects, funding can be based on estimated hours and hourly rates; student stipends in the range of \$1,000 per semester are available for students who work on a project with/under a faculty member during the school year.
- ALL funding, including project expenses, will be paid in the form of Faculty Stipends, whether for course-related projects or for non-course, non-classroom projects.
- *No course or project proposal may exceed \$10,000 in total funding.*
- Reimbursement for out of pocket expenses will be incorporated into the Faculty Stipend, and faculty, therefore, is responsible to manage those payments. Student stipends for students working with faculty on a non-course, non-classroom project will be paid through the Financial Aid package they receive from Pratt.
- Project participants who are not Pratt affiliated (i.e., faculty member, administrator, or student) are not eligible to receive this funding.
