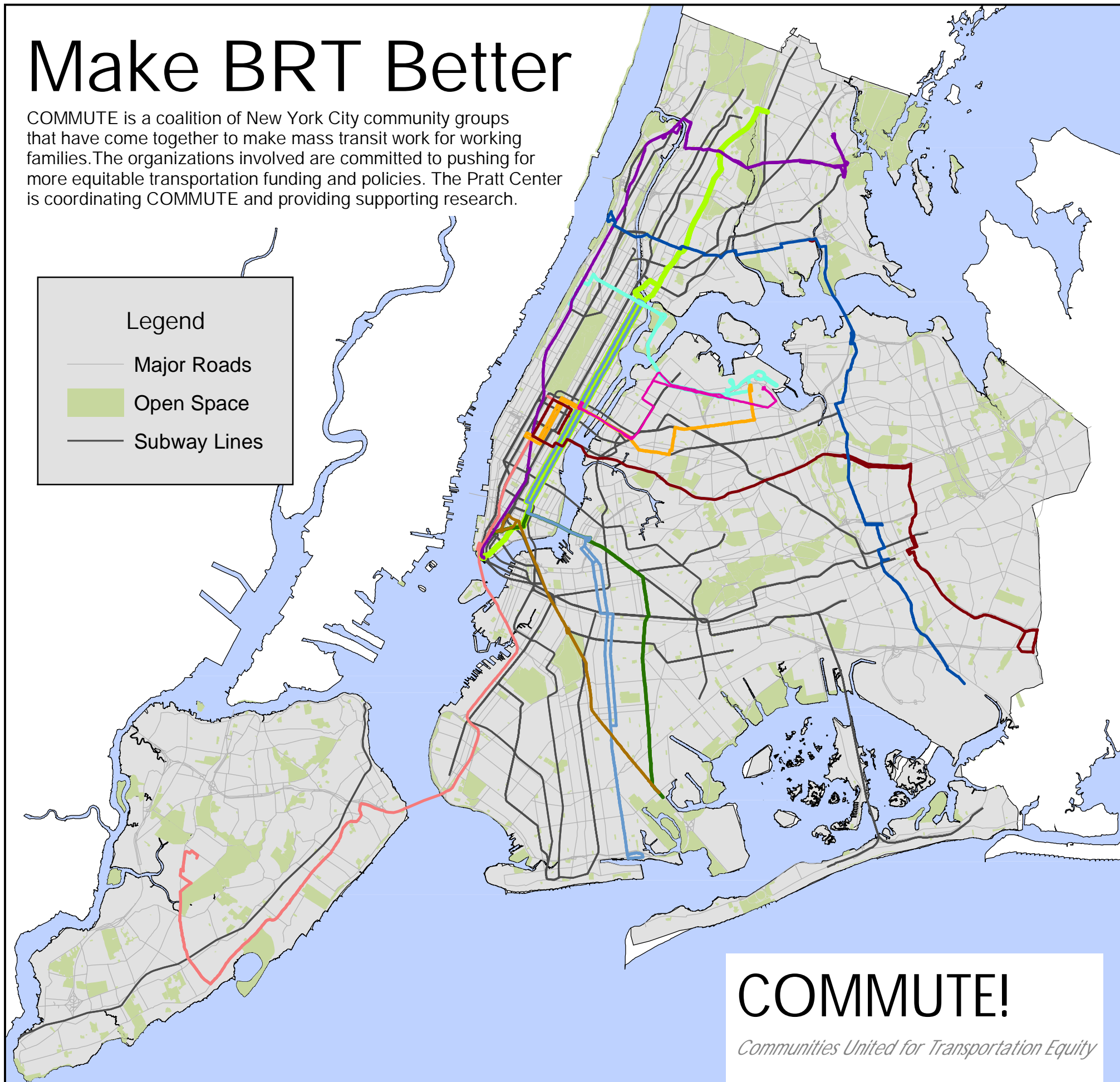


# Make BRT Better
